



**FCCS: Resource Limited
Skill Station Equipment List**

<p>Packaging the Patient</p>	<p>This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as <i>available</i>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A mannequin or volunteer • Blanket (preferable a space type, thermal, or military type [hypothermia prevention and management kit]) • Litter and litter straps or similar • Padding: additional blankets, chucks, clothing, sheets, or towels • Simulated medications for sedation and pain control (eg, morphine, ketamine, midazolam) • At least one “device” (eg, intravenous catheter, intraosseous needle, etc.) • Foley catheter and drainage bag • Ear plugs and safety glasses • Patient "belongings" (wallet, cloths, jewelry) • Paper for documentation • Monitor or vital signs equipment: preferable SpO2, ETCO2, automated blood pressure cuff • Suction option (oropharyngeal and endotracheal or nasotracheal) • Easel or white board with corresponding pens • Dial-a-Flow IV extension set-up • Transport ventilator & tubing • Chest tube and either a flutter valve (eg, Heimlich valve) or chest drain system • Other drains or devices (eg, bulb drains, additional invasive catheters, external fixation, etc.) <p>Handout: Package for Transport</p>
<p>Transport Ventilator Setup</p>	<p>This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as <i>available</i> (at a minimum need a transport ventilator and test lung):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resuscitation mannequin (intubated with IV) with working lungs or a test lung • A transport ventilator with power supply or charged battery and appropriate accessories (tubing, filter, power, etc. *may use simulated oxygen) • Nasogastric tube • Endotracheal suction catheter • Tape (preferably silk) to secure devices

<p>IV Infusion Setup Without a Pump</p>	<p>This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as <i>available</i>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Simulated ketamine vial 500mg/10mL • IV bag solution: any combination of the following 100 mL, 250 mL, 500 mL or 1000 mL • 10 mL syringes • Needles for drawing medication from vials • Alcohol swab or another antiseptic wipe • Medication labels • Gloves • Standard IV tubing
<p>Burn Calculation Tabletop Exercise</p>	<p>This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as <i>available</i>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flipchart • PowerPoint presentation with or without projection <p>Handouts: Burn Worksheet & CPG ID:12</p>
<p>Mass Casualty Incident</p>	<p>This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as <i>available</i>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flipchart • PowerPoint presentation with or without projection <p>Handouts: Logistics tracker, Whole Blood Procedure, MASCAL Cards</p>
