



Dear FCCS: Crisis Management Instructor Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in becoming an instructor in the Society of Critical Care Medicine's Fundamental Critical Care Support: Crisis Management (FCCS: CM) program. The FCCS: CM Program Committee appreciates your commitment to improving patient care. The criteria for FCCS: CM instructor status requires that the applicant select one of the following pathways:

- Current Fundamentals instructors:  
Successfully complete either a self-directed or hosted FCCS: CM course with  $\geq 80\%$  posttest score
- Non-Fundamentals instructors:  
Successfully complete an FCCS: CM course including skill stations with  $\geq 80\%$  posttest score, and complete the instructor curriculum

In addition, applicants are required to:

- Submit the online instructor application, and if needed, a letter supporting critical care practice ratio
- Teach at least two components of an FCCS: CM course (presentation and/or skill station) within two years of instructor candidate application approval
- Meet one of these profession-specific criteria:

**Physician:**

- Proof of critical care certification or activity or board eligibility for certification **or**
- Proof of a minimum 50% critical care practice ratio from the ICU director\*

**Nurse:**

- Baccalaureate degree with critical care certification **or**
- Graduate or higher degree with proof of a minimum 50% critical care practice ratio from the ICU director\*

**Advanced Practice Provider:**

- Baccalaureate or higher degree with critical care certification **or**
- Proof of a minimum 50% critical care practice ratio from the ICU director\*

**Respiratory Therapist:**

- Baccalaureate or higher degree with proof of a minimum 50% critical care practice ratio from the ICU director\*

**Pharmacist:**

- Baccalaureate or specialty in critical care **or**
- Proof of a minimum 50% critical care practice ratio from the ICU director\*

\* *Critical care practice* is considered either a didactic or education-based role focused on the critically ill or injured patient. The practice requirement ensures, as much as possible, that the instructor will be comfortable with most of the lecture components and skill stations and can answer questions with credibility.

Critical care-certified practitioners will be accredited as instructors after successful completion of all criteria listed in this document. Instructor applicants with less than 50% critical care practice ratio may require a review before Instructor status is granted.

**FCCS: Crisis Management Course Instructor Letter  
Documenting Practice Ratio in Critical Care**

Dear ICU Director:
