Assessment of a Nonventilated Patient	This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as available: • 1 x 18-gauge intravenous (IV) catheter, peripheral • Adult-size nasal cannula • Pulse oximeter • Soft cervical collar • Electrocardiography (ECG) leads with sticky pads • Nasal cannula • Blood pressure cuff
Assessment of a Ventilated Patient	This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as available: • 1 x 18-gauge IV catheter, peripheral • Ventilator bridle/mouthpiece • Endotracheal tube • Patient restraints • Pulse oximeter • ECG leads with sticky pads • Ventilator • Blood pressure cuff
Family Involvement in the ICU	This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as available: • 1 x 18-gauge IV catheter, peripheral • Ventilator bridle/mouthpiece • Endotracheal tube • Patient restraints • Pulse oximeter • ECG Leads with sticky pads • Ventilator • Blood pressure cuff

Assessment of Spontaneous Awakening and Spontaneous Breathing Trials	This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as available: • 1 x 18-gauge IV catheter, peripheral • Ventilator bridle/mouthpiece • Endotracheal tube • Patient restraints • Pulse oximeter • ECG leads with sticky pads • Ventilator • Blood pressure cuff
Choice of Drug	This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as available: • 1 x 18-gauge IV catheter, peripheral • Adult-size nasal cannula • Pulse oximeter • ECG leads with sticky pads • Blood pressure cuff
Early Mobility	This skill station may be conducted using any of the following, as available: ECG Blood pressure cuff Pulse oximeter Femoral dialysis catheter, left Subclavian triple lumen, left Arterial line, right, radial Chest tube on water seal Ventilator IV infusion pumps/carrier with 4 drips connected to the triple-lumen catheter Foley catheter Jackson-Pratt drain x 2 Dobhoff tube
